Our Lady's Fell Walkers have two walks on Saturday 9th May 2026, from the market town of Settle in the Yorkshire Dales. Both walks involve a climb but with beautiful views. The A walk is 10 miles with a climb of 1600 ft and the B walk is 7.5 miles and reaches 310 metres at its highest point. The A walk is faster and higher, the B walk, lower and slower.

We are a friendly group and everyone is welcome. The coach leaves from the corner of School Lane and Church Road, Formby, at 8am on the day and you can book your place by ringing 01704 878548. There is always an early stop for coffee/tea/bacon barmes and time after the walk to visit shops, cafes and pubs in the area. Please wear good walking boots or shoes, weather appropriate clothing and bring a packed lunch together with something waterproof to sit on. Sticks can also be helpful particularly at this time of year.
