The installation of the new Church heating system at Our Lady's

After a long wait, work to replace the heating system at Our Lady's will commence this Tuesday. The work will take about 6 weeks to complete. The good news is that the contactors and surveyors do not require the closure of the church. Sunday Masses will continue as normal and we will be able to celebrate most weekday Masses at Our Lady's in that period of time. The only exception will be the week beginning Monday 15th May when Fr John will be leading the parish pilgrimage to Lourdes. There will be no services week. I am very grateful to all those involved for enabling the worship life of our parish to continue unaffected. There may be some disruption to the side benches in the church as the work progresses. However, all will be done to ensure that the church remains a safe place to enter. Outside mass times, the church will remain locked to enable the work to continue. The full costs of the work will not be known until it is all complete. We look forward to putting cold winters behind us!
