■ ADVANCE NOTICE: Parish Pilgrimage to Lourdes 2027

This will take place from **MONDAY 17th MAY to FRIDAY 21st MAY 2027** arranged by Northern Star Travel. Travelling by air, from Manchester to either Bordeaux or Carcassonne, with onward coach travel in France.

- Full board accommodation at 4* Hotel Eliseo for 4 nights.
- Daily pilgrimage programme including Mass whilst in Lourdes.
- Airport duty and passenger taxes, 1 suitcase 20kgs for the hold & services of Northern Star Travel Courier included.
- Also included this year, is a scenic half day excursion through the High Pyrenees to the mountain village of Gavarnie near to the Spanish border.
- The cost per person will be £740 in shared accommodation (double, twin or triple rooms).
- A very limited number of single rooms will be available at a supplement of £145 Per person.
- Age related travel insurance is also available at variable costs.

We are grateful to the travel company that despite the global increases being experienced across the industry, they have generously managed to increase costs by only £40 over last year's pilgrimage.

Booking forms, together with further information, will then be distributed and deposits collected during September. **Anyone requiring further information may contact the parish organiser, Mike Halford on 879508.** As we are an independent parish group, we do not have access to facilities for sick pilgrims needing medical assistance. These are provided by the Archdiocese in their pilgrimage each July.

PARISH DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY CONSULTATION : Securing Our Future Together

The Archbishop is consulting us on the future of our Archdiocese and what that will mean for the future of our Parish. This future is not far away

- Within 7 years the number of priests in the diocese will have halved.
- Within 12 years all of the priests in our Deanery will be retired.
- Within 14 years, without change, the diocese will run out of money to function.

We are asked how to restructure our Parishes, and deploy our resources, priests and lay roles to :

- develop our parish as part of a wider sustainable community?
- to look after the sick, the hospitalised, and the dying?
- maintain baptisms, communions, confirmations, weddings, and funerals with fewer priests?
- nurture faith within our local schools, deepen our community outreach, and encourage new shoots of faith to grow?
