Lourdes Pilgrimage 2024

Sincere thanks to all those who showed interest in the pilgrimage for October 2024 by signing the list by the main door of Our Lady's Church or by making telephone contact. The first week response was very encouraging. Single room occupancy is limited and early booking is advisable for those wishing this category of accommodation. The pilgrimage will take place from 7th to 11th October 2024 to coincide with the feast and month of the Holy Rosary. Travelling with Northern Star and staying at the Hotel Padoue on full board, the cost is expected to be £650 (an increase of only £20 from the cost in 2023!) with a single supplement of £160. Flights will be from Manchester with the destination airport to be advised at a later date.

Southport Hospital Cover

Traditionally our hospitals have offered 24/7 cover from Priests and it is our intention to continue this whenever possible. However, due to priest numbers, it is becoming extremely difficult (currently we only have 3 priests providing all this cover). It is advisable, therefore, for anyone going into hospital as a routine admission, that they request the Sacrament of the Sick from their Parish Priest, prior to being admitted. In an emergency, please ask the ward staff to call the priest on call. Should a priest not be available at that time, our Lay Chaplain, Maria Parker, will respond."
