## **Parish Notices**

#### The Heating of Our Lady's Church

On Friday 18<sup>th</sup> November, the heating system at Our Lady's Church failed. A preliminary visit by the heating engineers suspected a leak and the system was switched off. A further visit discovered leaking pipes under the floor outside the sacristy. The engineers suspected further leaks elsewhere in the church and asked for unrestricted access to the building to discover the true nature of the problem. The church was closed for five days to enable access. Having taken up parts of the church flooring, they found multiple leaks from pipes that were about 100 years old. However, they could not find the most serious leaks, which concerned them. The water supply to the pipes was completely switched off. Further inspection would have meant weeks of disruption and closure with no guarantees that the leaks would be found. At the end of their visits, they decided that given the condition of the underfloor pipe work and multiple leaks, the heating system was no longer viable and would have to be completely replaced. In the meantime, large gas heaters were delivered to the church to provide some warmth. All this happened just before the present cold snap!

So, what happens next? The Archdiocese has been informed and will meet with me next week to assess the situation. But whatever happens, the complete replacement of the heating system is a big job and a very expensive one. It will be some time before approvals are given and contractors appointed. In the meantime, I have asked for a third heater to be delivered to increase the warmth. Apart from that, we face the rest of the winter without proper heating. Let's pray for mild weather! The bright spot in all of this is that by next winter we will have a brand-new heating system, which will heat the church properly. Now we have the opportunity to rectify the heating problems once and for all. I shall keep you updated on the situation as things progress. Fr. John.
