**The Word For Children:-** Last weekend, I invited everyone in our Catholic community to reflect on the purpose of our Parish and its mission. As part of that reflection and listening process, I want to focus on the Liturgy of the Word celebrated for our children during Sunday Mass, previously known as 'Children's Liturgy'.

The previous Our Lady's and St. Jerome's parishes had a long and very generous history of Children's Liturgy. All was brought to a halt during the pandemic. Now that we have a new parish, and are in many ways starting again, I am beginning a conversation about this important work with our children. Would you consider helping with this work?

'The Word for Children' is the new name of this group. It focuses on two simple elements. This ministry is for young children and its purpose is to explain to them, and celebrate with them, the Word of God in the first part of the 11.00am Sunday Mass.
