Liverpool Archdiocese Centenary Pilgrimage to Lourdes

This weekend one thousand five hundred pilgrims are in Lourdes on the one hundredth anniversary of the very first official pilgrimage in 1923.

The Archdiocese of Liverpool is the first diocese in England to reach this historic milestone. Under the leadership of Archbishop Malcolm, they have travelled by air and jumbulance, with 300 youth also travelling by coach including one from Sefton. They are in Lourdes from July 21st to 27th.

The assisted or sick pilgrims are, as always, at the heart of the pilgrimage. So let those of us at home in our parish join with them and all those in Lourdes during this special anniversary year, by keeping everyone in our thoughts and prayers throughout the coming days.
