## Compassion Acts

## Formby Food Pantry - Blessed are the poor in Spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

The Gild Hall Activity Centre opened its doors on Thursday this week, to the new Formby Pantry shop and is run by local volunteers from Compassion Acts, a local Christian charity and Churches Together in Formby; the Food Pantry takes place on **Thursdays 11am – 1pm.** With the cost of living crisis more of us are finding budgets tight and the pantry is a weekly food club over a 12-month period, designed for people who are just about managing and to prevent poverty. Members pay £5 and choose groceries worth about £20 and can access a school uniform hub, benefits and debt advice, fuel bank and most importantly, enjoy mutual support and friendship through the ups and downs of everyday life. Formby Food Pantry members have said "it has been a life saver", "you have really helped me through a difficult time in my life", "it is making such a difference, thank you" and some members also volunteer. In the next month, we plan to open a warm space at the same time. This will be open to anyone, not just those using the Pantry.

This is part of our mission and outreach as a parish and we're delighted that it is being hosted in the Gild Hall Activity Centre. Thank you to Father John for welcoming us to the Activity Centre and to all the parishioners at Our Lady of Compassion for your very generous support: - the food donations collected each week, which go to the Pantry and local foodbanks, for your prayers and for those who help in so many ways.

Compassion Acts is a local Christian charity set up by churches in Southport and Formby. It aims to prevent poverty and support people who are experiencing poverty in all its forms. As well as running 7 foodbanks, 5 food pantries and many prevention projects, we work with schools, families, churches, retailers and other charities to prevent and minimise the impact of poverty. In 2021 the benefits/debt advice volunteer team helped 900 people to claim an average of £1,200 each last year in unclaimed benefits, with the result that most then didn't need foodbanks or food pantries.
