OLOC Fell Walkers

OLOC Fell Walkers will be walking out of Clitheroe on **Saturday 14.6.25**, with two circular walks from this Ribble Valley town with its Norman Castle and Park. The A walk is 9.5 miles with an ascent of 1257 ft and the B walk is 7.5 miles with no more than 200ft. The A walk is faster and higher and the B walk, lower and slower.

We are a friendly group and everyone is welcome. The coach leaves from the corner of School Lane and Church Road, Formby, at 8am on the day and you can book your place by ringing 01704 878548. There is always an early stop for coffee/tea/bacon barms and time after the walk to visit shops, cafes and pubs in the area.
