#### OLOC Fell Walkers

OLOC Fell Walkers have two circular walks on the 11th May 2024 from the Derbyshire Village of Eyam in the Peak District. The A walk is 10.6 miles and 2060 ft of ascent. We walk past a number of the village landmarks and out onto the moors, good views from Sir William Hill, through Abney Clough to Abney, returning via Bretton and Foolow. The B walk is 7.3 miles and 1060 ft. mostly on good tracks, walking through Eyam to Coombe Dale and returning via Stoney Middleton. Eyam is known as the "Plague Village" where the villagers isolated themselves for a year to try to contain an outbreak of bubonic plague. The A walk is higher and faster and the B, a slower, lower walk.

We are a friendly group and everyone is welcome. The coach leaves from the corner of School Lane and Church Road, Formby, at 8am on the day and you can book your place by ringing 01704 878548. There is always an early stop for coffee/tea/bacon barms and time after the walk to visit shops, cafes and pubs in the area. Please wear weather appropriate clothing and bring a packed lunch together with something waterproof to sit on. Sticks can also be helpful.

#### CAFOD - Sudan Emergency Appeal

The people of Sudan need our help urgently. We are launching an <u>emergency appeal</u> for donations to get aid to them on the biggest scale we can muster. When violence broke out last year in Sudan between government and paramilitaries, most aid agencies evacuated. Now, humanitarian workers are struggling to get back into Sudan to help, meaning severe delays in getting aid to the people, and the challenges of getting into areas where fighting is still going on remain. Many borders are shut as the government say they need to keep weapons out. But the Church and our local partners are still there. A collection will therefore be held at Masses on 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> April.
