## ■ OLOC Fell Walkers

OLOC Fell Walkers have two walks on **Saturday, 11th April 2026** from the Derbyshire Village of Tideswell in the Peak District. The A walk is 10 miles with a total ascent of 1800 ft and the B walk is 7 miles with little climbing. The A walk is faster and higher, the B walk, lower and slower. Both walks are scenic through limestone valleys surrounded by sheer cliffs along roads, forest trails and paths with some stiles.

We are a friendly group and everyone is welcome. The coach leaves from the corner of School Lane and Church Road, Formby, at 8am on the day and you can book your place by ringing 01704 878548. There is always an early stop for coffee/tea/bacon barmes and time after the walk to visit shops, cafes and pubs in the area. Please wear good walking boots or shoes, weather appropriate clothing and bring a packed lunch together with something waterproof to sit on. Sticks can also be helpful particularly at this time of year.
