Divine Mercy Service 2023

Sunday 16th April 2023 is the Feast of the Divine Mercy and we are delighted that we are once again able to hold a Divine Mercy Service on this day at Our Lady of Compassion Church. The service itself will start at 3pm and is expected to last just under an hour. (*Please note that this is a service, not a Mass. Masses will be said at the usual times on this day.*). The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available during the service.

OLOC Fell Walkers

Our walks on 15.4.23, both are circular and in Derbyshire and the Peak District. **Walk A** is 8 miles with ascent of 394 metres starting from Grindleford walking uphill to Hay Wood just north of Froggat. It follows a route crossing Burbage Brook and footpaths towards Hathersage. The walk then ascends to the natural plateau that is Carl Wark, an iron age hill fort and a further climb takes a footpath up to Higger Tor with amazing views over the surrounding area. The walk then descends taking a path north called Fiddlers Elbow, crossing Burbage Brook, following the rim of Burbage Rocks. The walk now goes over Burbage Moor and eventually reaches the rocky moorland Longshaw Estate, finishing in Grindleford.

Walk B is 7.5 miles with an ascent of 270 metres and also starts from Hay Wood, across the moor to Curbar and Baslow Edges with spectacular views of the granite escarpments over the moors. The route then takes us past Wellingtons Monument to Froggatt Village and along the River Derwent returning to our starting point. These are both wonderful walks but in an isolated locality and post walk we will all be gathering in The Grouse Inn to relax, the only place for liquid refreshment in the area. We are a friendly group and everyone is welcome. The coach leaves from the corner of School Lane and Church Road, Formby, at 8am on the day and you can book your place by ringing 01704 878548. Walk A is a higher, faster walk and B a lower, slower walk. There is always a stop for coffee/tea/bacon barms etc., Please wear weather appropriate clothing and boots and bring a packed lunch. Sticks are also handy if you have them.

Coronation Weekend

With the Coronation Weekend in May only a month away now, we wanted to pick up the pace with our plans, and further inform all parishioners of our progress. We will be holding three days of events:

Saturday 6th May – Coronation Day: There will be a live screening of the occasion in the Gild Hall Activity Centre, with teas, coffees and cakes. All are very welcome. This will be free, but ticketed to ensure capacity is monitored. Further details will follow over the next few weeks, once the event times are officially announced.

Sunday 7th May – Coronation Social: This will be an evening of social and live entertainment running from 7:00pm – 11:00 pm at the Gild Hall. There will be a quiz, a raffle, live music, singing and magic! The Event will be ticketed at £10 per person, which includes nibbles too. The cost is to help towards the three days. More details regarding ticket purchase also to follow soon.

Monday 8th May – Coronation Family Funday at the Gild Hall Activity Centre. Outside - aside of a special village treasure hunt and prize, there will be a (huge) bouncy slide, traditional outdoor games, children's craft stalls, a plant stall, tombola's and hot dogs. We are also currently firming up some live entertainment. Inside the activity hall will be craft and artisan stalls, teas, coffees, refreshments and freshly baked cakes and biscuits etc.

So now we are starting to look for people to put their names down to help, in many ways and combinations, with for example:

- Muscle power to help with lifting and moving.
- Time before the events setting up.
- Time during the events on stalls etc.
- Time clearing-up on the evening and day after.

Plus, we are ready to accept donations:

- For the tombola stalls (for the Bank Holiday Monday) we are hoping for chocolates and bottles. Being as the church is pending closure sometime following Easter for heating repairs, we would kindly like to request that any chocolates or bottle donations be dropped off at our home, at 4 Andrews Close.
- For the plant stall (for Bank Holiday Monday) any cuttings, flowers and small plants of any variety could these please be dropped off at the Gild Hall Activity Centre in advance of the Bank Holiday event, during the daytime on either Saturday 6th or Sunday 7th May.
