■ Venezuelan Earthquakes

Many thanks to all those who have donated to the emergency appeal to provide support to our neighbours in Venezuela following the devastating earthquakes. CAFOD have provided us with this update: "Two weeks after devastating earthquakes struck northern Venezuela, the emergency is far from over. Thousands of families remain without safe shelter, communities are still coping with missing family members, the loss of loved ones and little to no livelihoods, and the long road to recovery is only just beginning. While the immediate search and rescue phase is ending, Caritas continues to provide emergency assistance and accompany communities as they begin rebuilding their lives." ■ OLOC Fell Walkers

Our Lady's Fell Walkers have two walks on Saturday **8th August 2026** from the village of Coniston in the Lake District National Park. The A Walk is 7.5 miles with an ascent of 2600 ft and the B walk is 6.36 miles with an ascent of 436 ft. Both walks have some parts which are quite steep and rocky. The A walk is higher and faster and the B walk, lower and slower.

We are a friendly group and everyone is welcome. The coach leaves from the corner of School Lane and Church Road, Formby, at 8am on the day and you can book your place by ringing 01704 878548. There is always an early stop for coffee/tea/bacon barmes and time after the walk to visit shops, cafes and pubs in the area. Please wear good walking boots or shoes, weather appropriate clothing and bring a packed lunch together with something waterproof to sit on. Sticks are likely quite necessary on these walks and please remember to bring adequate fluids if the weather is very sunny, together with sunscreen.



PARISH DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY CONSULTATION : Securing Our Future Together

The Archbishop is consulting us on the future of our Archdiocese and what that will mean for the future of our Parish. This future is not far away

- Within 7 years the number of priests in the diocese will have halved.
- Within 12 years all of the priests in our Deanery will be retired.
- Within 14 years, without change, the diocese will run out of money to function.

We are asked how to restructure our Parishes, and deploy our resources, priests and lay roles to :

- develop our parish as part of a wider sustainable, community?
- to look after the sick, the hospitalised, and the dying?
- maintain baptisms, communions, confirmations, weddings, and funerals with fewer priests?
- nurture faith within our local schools, deepen our community outreach, and encourage new shoots of faith to grow?
