## ■ OLOC Fell Walkers

Our Lady's Fell Walkers have two circular walks on **Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2024** from Grange over Sands, once a fashionable seaside resort on the north side of Morecambe Bay in Cumbria. The A walk is about 10 miles with an elevation of approximately 1250 ft and the B walk about 7 miles with around 700 ft of elevation. The A walk is faster and higher and the B walk, lower and slower.

We are a friendly group and everyone is welcome. The coach leaves from the corner of School Lane and Church Road, Formby, at 8am on the day and you can book your place by ringing 01704 87548. There is always an early stop for coffee/tea/bacon barm and time after the walk to visit shops, cafes and pubs in the area. Please wear weather appropriate clothing and bring a packed lunch together with something waterproof to sit on. Sticks can also be helpful and wet weather gear in view of the recent rains.
