

OLOC Fell Walkers

Our walks on Saturday 12th August 2023 are in the Lake District. The A walk is a circular walk, around Grasmere, of 8 miles with a total ascent of 649m and the B, a linear walk of under 7 miles from Ambleside to Grasmere with a total climb of 1000 ft.

Anyone not wanting to walk could spend the day in Grasmere, or alternatively, get off the coach at Ambleside and catch the bus to Grasmere later in the day as our coach will not be stopping in Grasmere on the return journey. The bus runs every 30 minutes (and if appropriate, you can use your senior citizens bus pass).

The A walk is a higher, faster walk and the B is a lower, slower walk. There is always a stop for coffee/tea/bacon barns on the way out and time after the walk to visit local cafes, shops and pubs. Please wear weather appropriate clothing and bring a packed lunch. Sticks can also be helpful. We are a friendly group and everyone is welcome. The coach leaves from the corner of School Lane and Church Road, Formby, at 8am on the day and you can book your place by ringing 01704 878548.
