### OLOC Fell Walkers

Our walks on **Saturday 12.4.25** are from the beautiful market town of Grassington in Upper Wharfedale, in the outstanding scenery of the Yorkshire Dales National Park. The A Walk is just under 10 miles with a total ascent of 1285 ft. The B walk is 7.22 miles with an elevation gain of 592 ft with no significant climbs although there are some easy stepping stones across a beck and stiles to navigate. The A walk is faster and higher and the B walk, lower and slower. We are a friendly group and everyone is welcome. The coach leaves from the corner of School Lane and Church Road, Formby, at 8am on the day and you can book your place by ringing 01704 878548. There is always an early stop for coffee/tea/bacon barms and time after the walk to visit shops, cafes and pubs in the area. Please wear weather appropriate clothing and bring a packed lunch together with something waterproof to sit on. Sticks can also be helpful.
