Our Lady's Fell Walkers

Due to unforeseen circumstances OLOC Fell Walkers have had to change the destination for the walks on **Saturday 10th September 2022** and will now be going to the beautiful market town of Grassington in Upper Wharfedale, in the outstanding scenery of the Yorkshire Dales National Park.

Walk A is 10 miles with 1800ft of Ascent. The walk follows a route along Sedber Lane to Linton Falls, turning right in a north-westerly direction following the River Wharfe past Ghaistrills Strid to Lower Grass Wood, then up to Gregory Scar, skirting Bastow Wood to the village of Conistone. The walk then heads north-easterly up Bull Scar with with a small scramble off the Dib to cross the Dales Way, along Bycliffe Road to Kelber Gate and Kelber. Then heads south back to Grassington via Bare House and Kimpergill Hill. Walk B is 7½ miles on very easy clear paths along the Dales Way beside the River Wharfe to Hebden and Hole Bottom. There will be some excitement crossing Hebden Beck over steppingstones, after which the path continues to Loss Gill Bank and Yarnbury, where the walk descends gently along Moor Lane and then across fields back to Grassington. We are a friendly group and everyone is welcome, including non-walking partners who would like to visit our destination whilst their other half enjoys the walk. The coach leaves from the corner of School Lane and Church Road, Formby at 8am on the second Saturday of each month and you can book your place by ringing 01704 878548. Walk A is a higher, faster walk and walk B is a lower, slower walk. There is always a stop for coffee/tea/bacon barms, etc on the way out and time after the walk to visit local cafes, shops and pubs. Please weat weather appropriate clothing and boots and bring a packed lunch. Sticks are also handy if you have them.
