OLOC Fell Walkers

Our walks on 11.3.23 are both circular and are in the Peak District in Derbyshire. Walk A is 9 miles with ascent of 394 metres starting from Hay Wood just north of Froggat and follows a route crossing Burbage Brook and footpaths towards Hathersage. The walk then ascends to the natural plateau that is Carl Wark, an iron age hill fort and a further climb takes a footpath up to Higger Tor with amazing views over the surrounding area. The walk then descends taking a path north called Fiddlers Elbow, crossing Burbage Brook and then following the rim of Burbage Rocks. The walk now goes over Burbage Moor and eventually reaches the rocky moorland Longshaw Estate back to our starting point.

Walk B is 7.5 miles with an ascent of 270 metres and also starts from Hay Wood, across the moor to Curbar and Baslow Edges with spectacular views of the granite escarpments over the moors. The route then takes us past Wellingtons Monument to Froggatt Village and along the River Derwent returning to our starting point. These are both wonderful walks but in an isolated locality and post walk we will all be gathering in The Grouse Inn to relax, the only place for liquid refreshment in the area.

We are a friendly group and everyone is welcome, including non-walking partners who would like to visit our destination whilst their other half enjoys the walk. The coach leaves from the corner of School Lane and Church Road, Formby, at 8am on the second Saturday of each month and you can book your place by ringing 01704 878548. Walk A is a higher, faster walk and the B a lower, slower walk. There is always a stop for coffee/tea/ bacon barms etc., on the way out and time after the walk to visit local cafes, shops and pubs. Please wear weather appropriate clothing and boots and bring a packed lunch. Sticks are also handy if you have them."

Prisoners of Conscience Each year Christians against Torture provides us with details of people currently being held in prison for political reasons. They have done nothing criminal. Next week you will be offered a photo with details and address of your prisoner. What to do: 1. Please would you write a non-religious message of hope on a non-religious post card or greetings card. 2. Address it. 3. Stamp it and post it (postage will be no more than £1.80). We know it gives prisoners great comfort to realise that they are not forgotten. Sometimes their treatment improves greatly when the prison authorities understand that their names are known in other countries.
