OLOC Fell Walkers

Our Lady's Fell Walkers have two circular walks on Saturday 11th November 2023 setting off from Tittesworth Water Visitor Centre, Staffordshire, on the edge of the Peak District. The A walk is 9 miles long with 1800 ft of climb and the B walk, 6 miles long with 900 ft of climb. The A walk is a higher, faster walk and the B is a lower, slower walk. We are a friendly group and everyone is welcome. The coach leaves from the corner of School Lane and Church Road, Formby, at 8am on the day and you can book your place by ringing 01704 878548. There is always a stop for coffee/tea/bacon barns on the way out and time after the walk to visit in this case, the local cafe and pub.
