The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord (2nd February)

'The Presentation' happens on the Sunday 40 days after Christmas Day. It was 40 days after the events in Bethlehem and the birth of Jesus that his parents presented Him to God the Father in Jerusalem at the Temple. Scripture tells us that whilst at the Temple two people recognised Jesus for who He was. Simeon and Anna, wise in years, spent their time devoted to God at the Temple. Now they meet Him face to face – God in their midst.

Simeon's words, in response to recognising the Lord, are said throughout the world, each night, in what is known as the 'Nunc Dimittis' during compline (or night prayer):

"Lord, now you are letting your servant depart in peace, according to your word; for my eyes have seen your salvation that you have prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel."

Luke 2: 29-32 ESV-CE

This feast day is also known as 'Candlemas' as candles are often blest and lit on this day in reference to Jesus being a 'light to the Gentiles'.

St Paul Miki (SJ) **St Paul Miki (SJ) and Companions** (6th February)

Nagasaki is a word, for most people outside of Japan, synonymous with the atomic bomb dropped there at the end of WWII. However, Holy Mountain overlooking Nagasaki is the site of crucifixion for 26 Christian martyrs in 1597.

Brother Paul Miki, a Jesuit and a native of Japan, has become the best known among these martyrs. While hanging upon a cross, Paul Miki preached to the people gathered for the execution:

"The sentence of judgment says these men came to Japan from the Philippines, but I did not come from any other country. I am a true Japanese. The only reason for my being killed is that I have taught the doctrine of Christ. I certainly did teach the doctrine of Christ. I thank God it is for this reason I die. I believe that I am telling only the truth before I die. I know you believe me and I want to say to you all once again: Ask Christ to help you to become happy. I obey Christ. After Christ's example I forgive my persecutors. I do not hate them. I ask God to have pity on all, and I hope my blood will fall on my fellow men as a fruitful rain."

Missionaries returned to Japan in the 1860s, at first they found no trace of Christianity. At first, there seemed no evidence of Christianity until they found that thousands of Christians lived around Nagasaki and that they had secretly preserved the faith.
