OLOC Fell Walkers have changed their walk plans for Saturday 12.7.25 as their original destination of Llangollen is the venue for the 2025 Eisteddfod, which means the town would be inundated with visitors and make parking more than difficult. Consequently, we now have two walks from Sedbergh, one of the UK’s book towns, in the Yorkshire Dales National Park. The A walk is 10 miles and has 2500 of ascent. The B walk is a circular 7.5 miles through open fellsides, fields, riverside and country lanes. The A walk is faster and higher and the B walk, lower and slower.

We are a friendly group and everyone is welcome. The coach leaves from the corner of School Lane and Church Road, Formby, at 8am on the day and you can book your place by ringing 01704 878548.
