OLOC Fell Walkers

Our Ladies Fell Walkers will be travelling to Pateley Bridge in Upper Nidderdale for two walks in this Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty in the Yorkshire Dales on **Saturday 14th October 2023**. The A walk is 8.9 miles with an elevation of 950 ft, a height gain of 600 ft and the B walk is 6.9 miles with an elevation of 975 ft, a height gain of 625 ft. Pateley Bridge has pubs and cafes for refreshment and independent local shops to browse after our walks, not to mention the Oldest Sweet Shop in the World selling retro sweets of a bygone age. The A walk is a higher, faster walk and the B is a lower, slower walk. There is always a stop for coffee/tea/bacon barns on the way out and time after the walk to visit local cafes, shops and pubs. Please wear weather appropriate clothing and bring a packed lunch. Sticks can also be helpful. We are a friendly group and everyone is welcome. The coach leaves from the corner of School Lane and Church Road, Formby, at 8am on the day and you can book your place by ringing 01704 878548.
