

#### Monday Morning Movie – 11am, 17<sup>th</sup> March at the Activity Centre

This month's film is "Conclave", based on the novel by Robert Harris and starring Ralph Fiennes, Stanley Tucci and Isabella Rossellini. When the Pope dies suddenly and unexpectedly, it falls to Cardinal Lawrence (Fiennes) as Dean of the College of Cardinals to oversee the Conclave during which the new Pope will be chosen. He favours his trusted forward-thinking friend Cardinal Bellini, but as tensions, secrets and ideological differences come to light, the sequestered cardinals look increasingly unlikely to reach a consensus. And how will the female religious, who as Sister Agnes (Rossellini) comments are "meant to be invisible", impact the final outcome?

This film is rated 12. Open to all adults. Free entry and refreshments.

#### Mary's Meals

Mary's Meals Emergency appeal. Our Parish responds. Maybe you read the emergency appeal for help from Mary's Meals in the newsletter? The Justice and Peace group met this week and very much wanted to respond on behalf of the parish. It is tragic that in South Africa, more than 21 million children are suffering from malnutrition as a direct result of the worst drought in 100 years. The J and P are proposing to help by organising another Free Easter Raffle. A Yellow Letter with all the details of how we can work together to keep hope alive for some of these children will be available at the back of Church this week. It costs just 10p a day for Mary's Meals to feed a child at school. £20 would provide 200 nutritious school meals. How many meals could our parish donate by the end of Lent? (Spoiler alert-Raffle! Think bottles, chocolate, smellies, gift bags, baskets, fancy biscuits etc etc.). Maybe we can't save all the children, but let's give it a try! Thank you.
