From 25-27 November Marriage & Family Life Coordinators from different dioceses will gather at Hinsley Hall in Leeds for the Marriage & Family Life Conference. The theme for the conference is "This is the Hour for Love". We will share our pastoral experiences in supporting married couples to respond to the call to love in the vocation of marriage and family life. Please pray for the conference attendees. May the Holy Spirit guide us for a fruitful and inspiring reflection.

MOCK COP30 CONFERENCES ACROSS THE ARCHDIOCESE

Thirty-two secondary schools across the Archdiocese joined forces this month for two inspiring mock COP30 conferences. One at St Margaret Clitherow Centre in Liverpool and the other at Hope Academy in Newton-le-Willows. Organised by Andrew Holt (St Bede's Catholic High School, Ormskirk) and Karen Wynne (Liverpool World Centre) each school sent at least eight pupils to represent different UN nations. Together, they debated global responses to climate change and shared ideas for a sustainable future. The events were themed around the Jubilee Year's call to be *Pilgrims of Hope*, with a focus on:

- Laudato Si and Catholic Social Teaching
- Responding to the Climate Crisis
- o Climate Justice and Hope

Archbishop John Sherrington opened the day at Hope Academy with prayer and listened as pupils spoke passionately about the challenges facing their assigned countries and the actions needed to protect our planet. These conferences were a powerful reminder that young voices can lead the way in caring for creation.
