GOOD NEWS

• **YOUTH MINISTRY REVIEW OPEN MEETINGS**

In response to the Area 5 of the Archdiocesan Pastoral Plan (becoming a Church where young people and young adults flourish) we held two open meetings for anyone in the archdiocese to come and share thoughts about youth ministry. Over 70 people came and discussed ideas such as our hopes for young people, what the Church does that helps young people, where we are failing, and how we can work together to improve our provision. There were many suggestions made and all of these ideas have been recorded and will be fed into the report.

• **MISSION DAY**

In response to the Area 2 of the Archdiocesan Pastoral Plan (becoming a Church that honours the vocation of all the baptised), two Mission Day events were organised on 23rd and 25th April, at St Mary's church, Leyland, and St Margaret Clitherow Centre respectively. We had a good time with the fantastic keynote presentation on 'Exploring the Baptismal Priesthood' from Fr Peter McGrail, followed by four different lay ministry workshops (i.e. catechist, reader, evangelisation and Catholic social action). A big thank you to everybody who attended the two events. We hope you all had a good reflection on your own calling from God. One attendee said: 'The keynote speaker presented ideas that helped to underpin the exploration of mission'. 'A realisation that I have been called by God to walk alongside others,' said another.
