VISIT OF FATIMA STATUE AND RELICS

We had a good time with the visit of the Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima and relics of Saints Jacinta and Francisco on Monday 2 June. Over 280 people gathered at the Metropolitan Cathedral to pray with Our Lady. The day began with the procession and a Mass celebrated by Archbishop John, followed by rosary prayer (for world peace), and veneration of the saints' relics. We have deepened our understanding of Fatima's messages through the informative talks and film. The event concluded with a Holy Hour and Benediction.
