- **UPDATE ON THE YOUNG ADULT ASSISI PILGRIMAGE (DISCOUNT AVAILABLE)**

Young adults aged 18-35 are warmly reminded to secure their place on the Archdiocese of Liverpool's pilgrimage to Assisi, taking place from 29 November to 2 December 2026.

Organised in partnership with McCabe Travel, this special journey offers the opportunity to walk in the footsteps of St Francis during the 800th anniversary year. Pilgrims will visit key sites associated with St Francis and St Clare and learn more about the life of St Carlo Acutis. The cost of the trip includes flights, accommodation, transport, and all meals (except one dinner), with shared rooms provided.

A limited-time advance booking offer is currently available until Friday 17 April 2026.
