#### All Saints – November 1st

For all the saints who from their labours rest, who thee by faith before the world confessed, thy name, O Jesus, be forever blest. Alleluia! Alleluia! (*W.W. How 1823-97*)

When we call upon the saints in heaven they intercede on our behalf, asking God to help us in our time of need. The saints have lived exemplary lives, and their devotion to God can inspire us to lead a more faithful life. By praying to the saints, we can seek their intercession and ask for their guidance in our daily struggles in becoming saints of our own age.

"Your Christian history...is not over. Your saints are not silent.... Your saints are alive. They are the guarantors of your past and of your future" (St Pope John Paul II, Homily of April 21, 1990)

#### All Souls - November 2nd

The Church is composed of the faithful living upon the earth and those who have gone before us. Today, and throughout this month, we pray for those gone before us that, as they approach the throne of God, their souls are purified and their journey into the Holy Presence of God, started when they were called by name, reaches its completion.

God calls each one by name. Everyone's name is sacred. The name is the icon of the person. It demands respect as a sign of the dignity of the one who bears it. (*The Catechism of the Catholic Church 2158*)
